PROJECT OUTPUTS by 2021

- **A new holistic model of care for people living with dementia and older people combining sustainable business planning and care delivery**
CASCADE will develop state-of-the-art care services fully assimilated into the local community enabling people living with dementia to live well longer in their own home. This includes outreach activities and the ability to participate in holidays have vacations. Build on existing best practices and focus groups with all stakeholders.
- **Published evaluation reports showing the cost saving of these new ways of working**
Progress of the activities undertaken by the project partners are evaluated on an ongoing basis & the learning from each country will be shared with others.
- **A suite of telemedicine & technology solutions combining existing technology from health & commercial settings in innovative ways**

Design of the Centre of Excellence in Dover (Kent)

- **New multi-lingual learning package providing training for all people**
Learning and development programmes, virtual and class room, for people living with dementia and their carers, workforce in healthcare and the wider community.
- **New facilities for people living with dementia and others**
50 new beds across two countries for people living with dementia (30 residential and 6 guesthouse with care beds at the Centre of Excellence + 10 at Guesthouse for Dementia, both in Kent (UK) + 10 new beds in Flanders with the accent on tourism and leisure activities for people living with dementia).
